

SWIFT AIR TO PARTICIPATE IN VOLUNTARY FAA SAFETY PROGRAM

PHOENIX, Ariz. [Feb. 11, 2008] – Swift Aviation Group, an Arizona-based provider of aviation services, announced today it has signed a memorandum of understanding with the Federal Aviation Administration establishing a comprehensive Aviation Safety Action Program (ASAP) to provide extensive safety reporting tools to its operations, maintenance and flight crew personnel.

ASAP was designed by the FAA to enhance aviation safety through the prevention of accidents and incidents. Under this voluntary program, Swift Air and the FAA will cooperate to improve aviation safety through self-reporting, joint follow-up and prompt corrective action.

“Everything we do at Swift begins and ends with safety and by participating in ASAP we now have a formal way to work with the FAA to proactively ensure we provide a safe environment for our customers,” said Michael White, Vice President, Flight Operations for Swift Air.

According to the FAA, identifying precursors to accidents is essential to further reducing the already low accident rate. Under an ASAP, safety issues are resolved through corrective action rather than through punishment or discipline.

While the majority of the nation’s major passenger airlines are already enrolled in ASAP, Swift Air is one of the few charter airlines in the country that has agreed to participate in ASAP.

“Participating in ASAP not only the right thing to do for our customers, it’s also a strategic business decision that we believe will set us apart from our competitors,” said White. “In fact, we’re one of only a handful of companies to participate in all four areas of the program – pilots, maintenance, dispatch and flight attendants – even among the major commercial carriers.”
